The Katar was created centuries ago as an armor-piercing melee weapon—a purpose it serves well in the Apex Arena.




DID YOU KNOW?

Each style of Katar has its own ties to locations in the Outlands. This includes the chase variant, Nitride, which is reminiscent in its own way.







